Reporting Associates

Reporting associates is a major responsibility, and it is important to keep records complete and correct. The new associates of your chapter trust that their records and fees will be properly prepared and submitted. Here are four simple steps to report your associates.

These steps must be complete for associates to receive their badge and certificate!

- 1. Add the new member to OmegaFi.
- 2. Have him log in and complete his Application of Membership on OmegaFi.
- 3. Complete the Association Report under the Sigma Tau Gamma tab by providing the association date.
- 4. If you have any questions, contact your OmegaFi account manager at (800) 276 6342.

Remember the deadline for the association report is September 30, 2014.

The thing I love about the second four weeks of the Path of Principles program is that it mirrors the concept of an internship. We teach in the first four weeks. Then we empower our new members to put what they learned, together with their own talents, to work for Sigma Tau Gamma. We do that in a structure that provides coaching from older members.
