Sigma Tau Gamma scholarship/faculty advisor | chapter advisory team



The Faculty Advisor will serve as the primary liaison between the Chapter's host institution and the Undergraduate Chapter and serve report to the Lead Chapter Advisor on the Chapter Advisory Team. The Faculty Advisor will be responsible for: ensuring that chapter grade reports are provided to Fraternity Headquarters and the Chapter's Scholarship Chair, provide endorsement needed for the chapter to be a recognized student organization, and assist the Lead Chapter Advisor in developing and maintaining a partnership with the Fraternity and Sorority Life Office and host institution.

In addition, the Faculty Advisor will work with the Scholarship Chair to promote and best support the academic standards and habits of the undergraduate chapter. Advisors should be able to lead by example and demonstrate to the undergraduate chapter what it means to be an excellent Member of Sigma Tau Gamma, the Greek Community, and the institution as a whole.

The Faculty Advisor does not need to be a member of Sigma Tau Gamma or any other Greek Organization, nor needs to be male. Faculty Advisors should attend two chapter meetings each academic semester to maintain a presence and rapport with members, and/or inform members of current University policies and available resources. Qualified candidates will be appointed by the undergraduate Chapter President, with approval by the undergraduate Executive Board.
