MEMBER SAFETY AND STANDARDS ADVISOR | CHAPTER ADVISORY TEAM



The Member Safety and Standards Advisor will serve as the primary advisor to the Chapter's Member Safety Chairman and the Standards Board Chairman and will report to the Lead Chapter Advisor on the Chapter Advisory Team. In addition, the Member Safety and Standards Advisor will assist in mentoring all undergraduate members on successful member safety practices and adhering to the standards set forth by our Principles and the Code of Conduct of the Fraternity. The most effective advisor will be able to lead by example and model to the Member Safety Chairman, the Standards Board Chairman, and all undergraduate members what it means to be an excellent member of Sigma Tau Gamma.

Advisors should be outgoing, risk-averse, and willing to help undergraduate members understand why we make decisions to ensure the safety of our brothers and friends of Sigma Tau Gamma. Previous undergraduate experience in Risk Management or Judicial Board is a plus, but not required to be successful in this role.

The Member Safety and Standards Advisor can expect to lead one 30-minute coaching/check-in call with the Member Safety Chairman each month, and can expect to attend or call into two Standards Board meetings per month. Advisors can expect to participate in monthly conference calls with the full Chapter Advisory Team. Ideally, the Member Safety and Standards Advisor should plan to visit campus at least once times per academic semester, which may include Chapter Meetings, Standards Board Meetings, or Ritual Ceremonies. Qualified Candidates will be appointed by the Lead Chapter Advisor and serve for two years, alternating with other members of the Chapter Advisory Team.
