A qualified applicant must be a senior who is a member of Sigma Tau Gamma. They must be in good standing and will graduate by the 31st day of December in the year of application. Applicants need not be recipients of chapter level awards. All chapters may submit up to three applications for the Dent "Man of the Year" award.

Applicants must submit the following:

- Dent Application
- Original certified college transcript. Photocopies will not be accepted
- High quality digital photograph (not from Facebook)
- Two letters of recommendation. One from a fraternity representative (not current undergraduate) and another from a campus advisor to a student organization other than your chapter or faculty member. Letters must be mailed or emailed to the Headquarters by the authors.

Finalists will be notified on May 30. Do not call the Headquarters seeking information on recipients prior to May 30.

Finalists will be selected from the full pool of eligible candidates. Finalists will be interviewed during the Fraternity's Annual Meeting at Grand Chapter to determine a "Man of the Year." All finalist receive a Ellsworth C. Dent "Man of the Year" medallion, certificate and stipend of \$500. Finalists must be present to receive the stipend.

Application must be received by April 15. No late applications will be accepted.
